WASHINGTON BRIDGE chased a bit off the rail, moved up inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch, gained the lead under some urging alongside the runner-up in deep stretch and won clear. IT TIZ had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear into the second turn, fought back inside the winner to deep stretch, then could not match that one while clearly second best. POINT OF REFERENCE settled a bit off the rail then angled in, moved up along the fence into the stretch, came off the rail a sixteenth out and could not offer the necessary late kick. GRIPSHOLM CASTLE broke out a bit, chased outside then alongside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. ELLAFITZ sped to the early lead, dueled outside a rival, stalked into the second turn, dropped back between foes on that bend and had little left for the stretch.
