### Footnotes

NORTH FORK chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, drifted in a bit while taking a short lead in midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. REGAL FEVER dueled inside then stalked along the rail, re-bid from the fence in the stretch, fought back in the final furlong and went willingly to the wire. BEAREMPIRE broke slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued outside a rival or a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, was in tight off heels in midstretch and bested the others. CLEAR TO CANADA four wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came out four wide again into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MORGANOUSKA had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in on the backstretch, was between horses nearing midstretch then was in tight off heels approaching the eighth pole and weakened. DUNSCOMBE angled in and settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. LUV DRAGON between horses early, chased outside a rival or just off the inside, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. FREE BEER three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, angled out into the stretch and did not rally. A BIG TO'DO angled in and saved ground off the pace to the stretch and was not a threat.
