FAST BULLET stalked outside a rival then off the rail, bid three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage nearing midstretch and won clear under a tap with the whip turned down and a moderate hand ride. WALL DANCE between foes early, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and gained the place late. INDUSTRY LEADER stalked inside then a bit off the rail, angled in again on the turn, bid along the fence, took a short lead into the stretch, was not a match for the winner and lost second late. SPEED BIAS sped to the early lead, dueled inside, inched away leaving the backstretch, drifted off the rail on the turn, was between foes leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SANDYS DIAMOND chased three deep then off the rail, angled to the inside leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. TUXEDO BLUES prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked on the turn, fell back between horses leaving the bend and weakened in the stretch.
