Footnotes

B J BALLETT, stalked the pace four wide on the backstretch and between rivals into the turn, angled three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and pulled clear under urging. SANTA FE EXPRESS, had a rail trip, bid inside on the turn and took a short lead, dueled inside the winner in midstretch and bested the others. JOHN'S HOPE, also had a rail trip and picked up the show. HEIDIJIM N' GRANT trailed not far back five wide early, angled in on the turn, came out a bit in midstretch and put in a late bid at third. SELF TAUGHT, pulled between foes early, continued toward the inside and lacked the needed response. HALO MISSY, a bit crowded at the start, chased between rivals, continued outside a foe on the turn and weakened. SWEET KYLEE, broke outward, stalked the pace outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. ROSES TONITE, sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside the runner-up on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
