**Footnotes**

SELF FEEDER (IRE) saved ground close up, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied gamely under urging, bumped with MR LIGHTFOOT late but bested that one. MR LIGHTFOOT (IRE), settled outside the winner, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead in midstretch, fought back when challenged, bumped with the winner and steadied slightly late and just missed. SPECIAL QUEST (FR) settled outside a rival, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the show late. PAVILLON (BRZ), also settled outside a foe, split horses three deep into the stretch, angled in some and was edged for third. ROBYNHOOD saved ground in a good position, went around a foe in midstretch and was outfinished inside. OTAVALO (IRE) came a bit off the rail on the backstretch, was outside DEL MAR GRAY on the second turn, then offered a mild late bid. DEL MAR GRAY, saved ground unhurried, came out on the second turn, split horses in midstretch, waited briefly off heels in deep stretch then went between rivals late. COMMITISIZE was sent along to duel outside KID KATABATIC, battled between foes into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. KID KATABATIC sped to the early lead, dueled inside but had little left for the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in deep stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the contact between them.
