Footnotes

PLEASANT THUNDER lagged back inside on the backstretch, split horses into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up outside foes late. TREASURE COLONY chased inside, came out into the stretch, went around the early leader then angled back to the rail in midstretch, bid along the fence in deep stretch and went on gamely to just miss. SUPER FLO chased a bit off the inside, moved up outside a rival on the turn, took command in upper stretch, kicked clear but was caught between foes late. ZULU SECRETS chased between horses then off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. OURFAVORITEONE broke out a bit then steadied after the start, settled outside the winner then inside, split horses in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DULCE HELADO chased outside, dropped back off the rail and was done early. LADY'S CAPER angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn and gave way. BREEZING HOME had good early speed and dueled inside, kicked clear leaving the backstretch, shortened stride in the stretch and was eased but walked off.
