Footnotes

BRAVE SUN settled outside a rival then inside, moved up along the rail on the second turn, swung out into the stretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up past the eighth pole and drove clear under some urging with the whip turned down and steady handling. TICE pulled a bit early and had speed outside foes, was forced out on the first turn, took back and angled in, dueled inside on the backstretch, inched clear inside on the second turn, could not match the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. GARY'S GOT RHYTHM between foes early, chased inside, advanced along the rail on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and bested the others. NORWAY HOUSE angled in and saved ground off the pace to the stretch and did not rally. FALSTAFF LANE chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, split horses into the stretch and weakened. GET OFF THE SUGAR had speed inside then lugged out on the first turn, inched away then dueled outside the runner-up, dropped back on the second turn, drifted three deep into the stretch and gave way.
