UNUSUAL SUSPECT stalked outside a rival, went three deep into the final turn, continued off the inside on that turn and into the stretch and finished well to wear down the runner-up late under urging. TEMPLE CITY sent to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside to the stretch, held on well through the drive but was worn down in the late going. BUENOS DIAS (IRE) squeezed back between horses early, settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, went three deep leaving the last turn and into the stretch and finished with interest. TREAT GENTLY (GB) pulled her way along inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival then between horses on the backstretch, continued three deep on the final turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. WORTH REPEATING saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the final turn and around a rival into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MARLANG stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, continued between horses on the last turn and weakened in the stretch. BIG SHOT SYD three deep early, chased outside a rival then inside, continued along the rail on the backstretch and final turn, steadied in a bit tight leaving that turn and also weakened. WHERE'S THE REMOTE in tight between horses early, chased outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the last turn and had little left for the stretch.
