### Footnotes

WALL STREET WONDER sped to the early lead and angled in, set all the pace along the inside, kicked away in the stretch and held under urging. SEA RASCAL close up stalking the winner along the inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. SCOFIELD BARRACKS broke a bit slowly, settled just off the inside, went outside a rival on the turn, angled out into the stretch and picked up the show. ADRIATIC MOON steadied between horses midway on the backstretch to drop back just off the rail, was in tight off heels into the stretch, came out in the drive and lacked the needed rally. MAYBE YES bobbled at the start, tugged his way up three deep to stalk the pace, angled in alongside a rival into the stretch and weakened. GALLET MONSTRUO had speed outside the winner early, stalked just off the rail then between horses, dropped back leaving the turn and also weakened.
