MAZEL TRICK sped to the early lead, had a rail trip, responded when challenged and gamely inched away again under urging. DIXIE DOT COM, four wide into the first turn, stalked the pace off the inside, bid outside the winner on the second turn and through the stretch but could not match that one late. OPINE, close up three deep between horses early, continued to track the pace off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and weakened. CLOVER HUNTER, between rivals early, continued off the rail, inched forward approaching the second turn, came under urging on that bend and gave way.
