MUSICAL REVIEW pulled early, chased outside, moved up three deep on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn, then rallied under urging in the stretch to wear down the runner-up. NELLIE L broke in and bumped a rival, sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, kicked clear in the stretch but was worn down late. ZEE TOPPER pulled her way along inside early, came off the rail on the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. RED'S RAINBOW also pulled inside early, went outside a rival on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and did not rally. FLY GIRL a bit crowded after the start, settled just off the inside, went three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. CLEAR AS DAYLIGHT angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, fell back on the second turn, came around a rival into the stretch and weakened. HISTORICAL DRIVE three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, angled in for the second turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
