STACY'S HOPE chased off the rail then outside on the turn, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead a sixteenth out and won clear. IRREFUTABLE had speed inside then prompted the pace outside a rival, inched away and angled in leaving the turn, kicked clear in the stretch, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. MOONLARK three deep early, chased off the rail, split horses leaving the turn, found the inside into the stretch, came out past midstretch and just missed second. KILLER BEAR between horses early, angled in and saved ground off the pace, swung out into the stretch and bested the others. PACK YOUR BAGS chased a bit off the rail then inside, split horses a quarter mile out, continued off the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MENSA HEAT stalked outside on the backstretch and turn, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the drive. WINTER CAMP had speed outside the runner-up then inched away and angled in, dueled inside, dropped back leaving the turn, steadied slightly as rivals went by nearing the stretch, came out, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
