Footnotes

FINAL JOURNEY chased outside rivals down the backstretch, moved up outside on the turn, took command at the furlong marker and drew out in the late stages. PICK TO CLICK chased the leaders from the inside down the backstretch, angled out in the lane to rally and gain the place spot while no threat to the winner. BRAVE JUSTICE stalked the pace from the outside down the backstretch, remained outside into the lane and was outfinished for the second spot in deep stretch. BENEZIT chased the leaders between horses into the turn and lacked a rally when asked in the drive. BEST OF INTENTIONS went to the early lead from the inside, showed the way to the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. FREE BEER was far back down the backstretch and could make no impact in the stretch drive. FIERCE THUNDER prompted the pace from the outside down the backstretch and on the turn, but had nothing left for the stretch drive.
