**Footnotes**

DAZZLING DIAMONDS sped to the early lead, set the pace just off the rail throughout and held on very gamely under some urging. DYNATROL pulled her way along inside chasing the winner, came out a bit into the stretch, bid inside in late stretch and just missed. GAMBLINGSAVIRTUE unhurried three deep into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and closed gamely. BRASS SUPPORT pulled along the inside stalking the winner, dropped back a bit on the second turn and weakened some in the stretch. SLIM SLICE chased outside then between horses on the backstretch and second turn, lacked room off heels into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and could not summon the needed late kick. SQUARE ANGEL (BRZ) broke slowly, saved ground without early speed to the stretch and improved position. WARP allowed to settle outside a rival, continued off the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. REPAYMA (NZ) chased three deep, moved up outside into and on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. FANCY LOCKET close up stalking the pace outside a rival then off the rail leaving the second turn, also weakened in the stretch. SPANISH BEAM saved ground off the early pace, came out leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and had little left in the stretch.
