Footnotes

SECRET CAPER stalked off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. MY HONEY BUNNY dueled inside a rival but off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, stalked a bit off the fence on the turn, re-bid between horses in deep stretch, put a head in front but was caught on the line. HAGERSTOWN dueled outside the runner-up on the backstretch, inched away and angled in for the turn, kicked clear on the bend, fought back inside in deep stretch but was outfinished late. HOPEFUL SEASON chased outside or off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and had a mild bid. DOTTED SWISS chased a bit off the inside, steadied in tight off heels past midway on the backstretch, came out into the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PAM AND GAYLA chased inside on the backstretch, dropped back and came out on the turn and weakened. FLYING CAPOTE sent outside a rival, drifted out a bit on the backstretch, continued off the rail, angled in on the turn and also weakened.
