GOOD JOURNEY angled in between horses into the first turn, moved up outside on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch, swept to the front and drew clear under a strong hand ride. POKER CREEK pulled his way along inside stalking the early pace, saved ground to the stretch, came out in midstretch and gained the place late. CORPORATE SALE sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, was no match for the winner in the stretch, lost second late and just held third. HEYERDAHL broke out a bit, angled in and saved ground, pulled his way into a tight spot and steadied leaving the first turn, trailed inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and put in a late bid at the show. DYNA KING pulled a bit and chased along the inside to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. GOOD TIME BENJI (IRE) close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail, came between horses into the stretch and weakened. MIRAMAR GOLD chased between horses early then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival into and on the turn and did not rally. SERGIA well placed stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. MARK OF A WARRIOR settled three deep on the first turn and outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and failed to menace.
