Footnotes

TWO FOUR DANCER saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside on the second turn, forged to a short lead along the rail nearing midstretch and held on gamely under urging. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER stalked the pace outside a rival then between horses nearing the second turn, bid three deep on that bend and into the stretch and continued willingly but was outgamed. KIMORA allowed to settle outside then off the rail to the stretch and picked up the show. TONIETTA unhurried along the inside early, came out on the second turn and did not rally. DREAMIN N SCHEMIN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled between horses on the second turn, was squeezed a bit while weakening into the stretch and dropped back. SILVER GOLD (NZ) threw her head a bit at the start, trailed outside a rival, dropped back into the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
