Footnotes

CRANK CALLER stalked outside a rival then between foes into and on the turn, lacked room off heels in upper stretch, waited then split horses in midstretch and rallied under some urging to prove best. AWESOME GRAF dueled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, inched clear in the stretch and held well but was caught late. GARY'S GOT RHYTHM stalked between horses then outside a rival, continued three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. BRITE BOBBY pulled his way along a bit off the rail on the backstretch, chased inside on the turn, came out leaving the bend and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRITE SHADOW had speed between foes then outside, dueled alongside a rival to the stretch and weakened. ZAWINNER close up stalking the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, remained along the rail and could not summon the necessary response. MY SECOND CHANCE broke slowly, settled inside then a bit off the rail, angled back in for the turn and did not rally. REVEILLE stalked four wide on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. NORTHERN DIPLOMAT pulled his way between horses to stalk the pace, was in a bit tight leaving the backstretch, dropped back off the rail on the turn and had nothing left for the stretch.
