### Footnotes

MILANIA raced outside a foe around the first turn, stalked off the rail down the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide and rallied in the middle of the track to take command inside the sixteenth pole. SAGE D'ORO stalked inside the winner around the first turn, stalked on the inside down the backstretch, went up to challenge between hoses into the second turn, came into the lane between foes, could not outfinish the winner but edged a foe for the place. BELLE GALLANTEY led the way into the first turn, held the advantage on the inside to midstretch, battled back inside in the final furlong and was edged for the place at the wire. WILD DATE pressed the pace on the outside down the backstretch and three deep on the second turn, began to weaken at the quarter pole and fell back in the lane. STORMY RANDIE was bumped at the start, saved ground around the first turn, chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, angled closer to the wood on the second turn, came out for the drive and did not threaten. CAUSEWAY EXPRESS broke out and was bumped at the start, pulled and steadied leaving the first turn, raced unhurried down the backstretch and around the second turn and made no impact in the lane.
