GATHERATTHEALTER came off the rail into the backstretch, chased outside then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, took the lead alongside the pacesetter under strong handling past the eighth pole and pulled clear under steady handling late. GRAEME CRACKERJACK chased a bit off the rail then inside, went around a rival leaving the second turn and into the stretch and picked up the place late. WARREN'S DR. YANG sped to a clear early lead, set the pace inside, opened a commanding advantage on the backstretch, shortened stride in the stretch, surrendered the lead past the eighth pole and just held third. WILD REVENGE chased outside then alongside a rival or off the rail, came out into the stretch and just missed the show. QUITE AN HONOUR angled in and settled inside, saved ground on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed response. FIRE SEEKER settled behind the runaway leader a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and weakened. RHYTHM IN MAY chased outside a rival then between foes, fell back some on the second turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat.
