TIZALWAYSOMETHING sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn, drifted out in the stretch and won clear under urging. LET'S GO CHEYENNE stalked off the rail on the first turn, bid alongside the winner on the backstretch, tracked that one on the second turn and into the stretch and just held second. HEIDI MARIA pulled along the rail early, chased inside then outside a rival on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just missed the place. ROXANNE O between horses early, saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled in again past midstretch and lacked the needed rally. IRISH CHIMES angled in and settled outside a rival or off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. CEE'S THE YEAR chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. BOUND FOR EDEN saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
