KETTLE CORN came off the inside into the first turn, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the backstretch and again into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging while lugging in some to gain the lead in deep stretch and proved best. DYNAMIC HOST angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, gained the advantage outside the a rival in midstretch, battled between foes in deep stretch and could not hold off the winner. UNCLE SAM three deep early, stalked outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the second turn, gained the advantage leaving that turn, fought back toward the inside in the stretch and clearly bested the others. COMMANDER sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, pulled his way to a clear advantage on the backstretch, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. JAVA MAN between foes early, chased inside, came out into the stretch and also weakened. BONFIRE KNIGHT (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, went between horses into the second turn, continued inside, came out into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
