Footnotes

EXCESS PLEASURE, sped to the lead and gradually angled in on the backstretch, opened up on the turn and drew off while being pushed along some in upper stretch, then was in hand late. MOST OF ALL, settled off the rail, angled in nearing the turn, came out a bit wide into the stretch and gained the place. CARR DE MON, also settled off the inside, moved up four wide into the stretch and was edged late for the place. NATIVE GOLD DIGGER, dropped back off the rail, angled in approaching the turn, split rivals into the stretch but lacked the needed late response. WISHINGMAKESITSO, dropped back away from the rail without early speed, was a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. KID SISTER, stalked the winner three deep early then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. A. P. MONEY saved ground forcing or tracking the winner's pace to the stretch and also weakened. HIGHER, went up inside to stalk the pace, dropped back on the turn and had little left.
