**Footnotes**

EL GATO MALO stalked outside then bid four wide a half mile out, was bumped into the turn, dueled outside a rival on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under a steady hand ride while being shown the whip. SANGAREE a bit slow to begin, was sent inside to stalk the pace, came out into the stretch and was second best. MOTORMAN unhurried off the rail then outside, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show. RATE OF CHANGE stalked between horses then bid three deep between foes, stalked again on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and lost the show late. STANFORD GOLD broke a step slowly, pulled his way along a bit off the rail then steadied a half mile out, continued off the fence on the turn, split rivals in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. DISTINCTIVE AFLEET broke slowly, settled a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. RECOIL had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. MONEY DROP a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MCARTHUR stalked between horses, was bumped and steadied into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. BELAFONTE dueled outside a rival then between foes leaving the backstretch, was bumped and steadied between foes into the turn, angled in leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of RATE OF CHANGE against the winner for alleged interference into the turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the latter was not the cause of the trouble to the former.
