Footnotes

COLONEL JOHN saved ground stalking the pace, slipped through inside into the stretch, came out in upper stretch, gained the lead outside the pacesetter nearing midstretch and drew clear under a crack of the whip and steady handling. OVEREXTENDED stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals into the stretch and edged a foe for the place. CAFE TORTONI came off the rail on the first turn and prompted the pace three deep, stalked on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and edged a rival for third. GALLON pulled early, bumped with a rival into the first turn, angled in and chased a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. MANY RIVERS sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched clear on the second turn but weakened in the final furlong. RIVERGRADE BOY pulled early, was bumped into the first turn, chased three deep, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. ORIENTATE ME stalked the early pace off the rail, bid between horses leaving the first turn and on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and also weakened.
