Footnotes

BAD BOY chased inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. HIGH STANDARDS sped to the early lead off the rail then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses on the turn and in the stretch, put a head in front past midstretch and just held second. YANKEE VISIONARY broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out in midstretch and just missed the place four wide on the line. SCAT THIEF pulled a bit early, chased outside a rival then just off the fence, found the inside on the turn, bid along the rail to gain the lead in the stretch, fought back in deep stretch and was edged late for the show. FORT FUNSTON stalked off the rail, bid three deep on the turn and four wide leaving the bend, was three wide again into the stretch and weakened late. SIX PACK ABS sent along inside and was in a bit tight off heels early, dueled along the rail, lugged out a bit on the turn, dropped back in tight again between foes into the stretch and weakened.
