OUR ROAD SCHOLAR angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out in the stretch, bid between foes in deep stretch to gain a short lead and held under left handed urging. TAMERIN had good early speed and dueled inside a rival, angled in on the turn, inched away leaving the turn, continued on well in the drive, could not hold off the winner late and just saved the place. ENTABENI chased three deep then off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn, angled out in the stretch and just got the show four wide on the line. ASHEE was in a good position chasing the pace outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and was edged for a minor award between foes late. POWEROFVOODOO settled off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FORTY DATES prompted the pace outside the winner, had that one inch away leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. SHE'S VERY RARE dropped back and angled in early, saved ground without speed to the stretch, came out in the drive and was not a threat. ANGEL BEFORE US stalked the pace inside, fell back some on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
