Footnotes

PORTFOLIO pulled between horses then was taken back off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside nearing the turn, waited behind foes leaving the turn, came out in upper stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch, split rivals with a bid to gain the lead passing the sixteenth pole and proved best under steady handling. TAKETHEMONEYANDRUN prompted the pace five wide then stalked four wide on the turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. GIRLS LACROSSE forced the pace four wide between foes then stalked three deep between rivals on the turn, took a short lead in midstretch, was between foes in deep stretch and bested the others. BENECIA dueled between horses then angled in and stalked on the turn, slipped through along the fence to take a short lead into the stretch, battled inside a foe in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. SCENT OF CHRISM pressed the pace between horses then stalked between foes, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and also weakened. SEARFAVORITSECRET broke in and a bit slowly, pulled her way up inside to duel for the lead, inched away a bit off the rail into the turn, drifted out and dropped back between foes into the stretch and gave way.
