MR GRUFF broke a bit slowly, pulled his way up four wide to the lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, remained clear past midstretch and held under urging. COMPARI stalked outside then alongside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn, was fanned out four wide into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. SIROCCO STRIKE chased a bit off the rail then inside, bumped with a rival into the turn, continued along the fence leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and bested the rest. ST LIAMS HALO stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch, was bumped early on the turn, remained just off the inside leaving the turn and lacked the needed late kick. AL INSTANTE (CHI) tugged his way along inside then a bit off the rail, came out from behind rivals into the turn, went three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ASH ZEE chased inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and did not rally, then was unsaddled a pole from the wire and vanned off. LT. HOPEFUL sped to the early lead and angled in, stalked inside, lugged out some into the turn, was between foes leaving the bend and weakened. A JEALOUS WOMAN broke a bit slowly and steadied, pulled hard and steadied again leaving the chute, chased outside a rival, steadied again when forced out into the turn and lacked a rally in the stretch.
