GO ON BABY sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn and proved best under urging. CONTINENTAL LU close up stalking the pace outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, could not catch the winner but held second. RUNWAY LOLLIPOP (ARG) chased outside a rival, also went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and gained the show. KISS AND FLY (IRE) angled in and saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside in the stretch and was edged for third. OUR FLING (NZ) stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, continued between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. AVRANCHES (FR) saved ground chasing the pace, came out between foes into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DREW AWAY hesitated to be off slowly, angled in and settled inside, was blocked along the rail through much of the drive, came out late and split foes nearing the wire. DANELETA (IRE) off a bit slowly, was in a good position tracking the winner outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SPLENDEUR (FR) pulled her way along and steadied off heels on the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. RISTRA angled in and settled outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat.
