JUST GO GUSTO sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between rivals, fought back on a short lead a bit off the rail in midstretch and held gamely between horses late under urging. TOM QUINN prompted the pace three deep to the stretch, fought back outside the winner in the drive and just missed between horses late. DEFYING LOGIC broke inward and slowly, settled along the rail, came out in midstretch and put in a late bid four wide on the line. RENZO SEAN chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, went around a rival in midstretch and continued willingly inside the others. ASTI stalked a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was outfinished. ROCKIN THE CITY had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, then weakened. ANEARLYALURE hesitated, broke outward and slowly, pulled her way along outside then four wide into the turn, continued outside on the bend and three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
