**Footnotes**

JOE'SGIRLISGOLDEN had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, took a short lead in upper stretch, fought back between horses under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. WARREN'S LADY SLEW close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid three deep past midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. LU BATON dueled inside, fought back on the turn and until late stretch and held third. DIXIE HAWKS pulled her way along to stalk between horses on the backstretch and most of the turn, continued outside a rival leaving the rail into the stretch and could not summon the needed late response. GRACE GRYDER settled a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn, continued along the fence in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. CAN CAN GIRL chased off the rail, angled in leaving the turn and lacked the needed rally. CHILLIWACK chased outside then off the inside, came three deep into the stretch and also could not summon the necessary response. WARREN'S WILD ONE stalked three deep between horses then off the rail on the turn and did not rally. RIGHTEOUSLY broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. MEETYOUATYOGI'S was in a good position stalking the pace four wide then three deep on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
