Footnotes

TREATHERLIKEALADY stalked the pace inside a foe down the backstretch, moved up on the inside to bid for the lead on the turn, took command nearing the quarter pole and held her foes safe to the wire while drifting out. WHERE'S HENRY stalked the pace four wide into the turn, came into the lane three wide, was floated out a bit at the furlong marker, went willingly to the wire. HAMMER THE BAY pressed the pace outside into the turn, was caught three wide around the turn, angled to the rail for the stretch drive and gained the show. SIR ALLISON sped to the lead between horses, remained between foes into the turn, relinquished the lead nearing the quarter pole, came out some leaving the furlong marker and weakened between horses in the final furlong. CRUXUS chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, angled over to save some ground around the turn, remained on the wood for the stretch drive and failed to rally. J MAN was off a bit slowly, chased on the inside down the backstretch, angled off the rail around the turn and lacked the necessary rally. IDONTROLLONSHABBOS chased the pace off the rail down the backstretch and outside a rival around the turn, remained on the outside through the lane and did not threaten.
