Footnotes

MACHO DORADO pulled inside to press the pace, was shuffled back into the turn, re-bid along the rail in the stretch to gain the lead and drew clear under a brisk hand ride and a snug hold late. KIM'S LEADING MAN pressed the pace three deep then stalked on the turn, entered the stretch four wide, drifted in and was clearly second best. HIGH SUCCESS dueled between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, was between foes in the drive and edged a rival for the show. AFLEET DEAL dueled a bit off the rail, fought back on the turn, was between horses nearing midstretch and weakened. TIME FOR ATONEMENT stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between rivals into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. CAPER'S EDGE off a bit slowly, chased outside a rival, was in tight between foes into the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
