SANAGAS (GER) tugged his way along under a rating hold stalking the pace three deep, bid three wide on the backstretch, took the lead into the last turn, angled to the inside, kicked clear, opened up in the stretch and proved best under some urging and strong handling. BOURBON BAY came a bit off the rail on the first turn to stalk the pace, went between foes on the second turn and backstretch, moved up three deep leaving the final turn and into the stretch and gained the place. FALCON ROCK (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, came out for room leaving the last turn, swung out into the stretch and bested the others. ASHTAR (CHI) chased outside a rival, advanced three deep on the backstretch and into the final turn, angled in just off the rail leaving that turn and could not offer the necessary late response. NORVSKY stalked a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the backstretch, tracked the winner again on the final turn and weakened in the stretch. MISS MATCH (ARG) took the early lead three deep than angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back on the backstretch, stalked on the last turn but weakened in the stretch. GOLDWAKI (GER) allowed to settle a bit off the rail, dropped well back in the stretch and was not a threat.
