**Footnotes**

STORMY LUCY had speed four wide then dueled three deep, took the lead nearing the stretch, inched clear under urging and held. BELLA'S FANTASY a bit crowded early, split horses on the backstretch then stalked toward the inside, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. CANDY AND NUTS settled outside then angled in a bit off the rail for the turn, swung out five wide into the stretch and edged a rival for the show. SPICED LATTE bumped at the start, settled outside a rival, went three deep a half mile out, angled in alongside a foe on the turn, came out some in the stretch, split horses past midstretch and just missed third. FIRE WISE stalked three deep, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. RUSH BABE pulled hard between horses early, angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. CHAMPAGNEANDCAVIAR bumped at the break, went up between horses then chased three deep or outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. KVELL had good early speed and dueled between horses to the stretch and weakened. NEVER ENDING LOVE settled inside, split horses leaving the backstretch, angled back in on the turn and failed to menace. JUST IMAGINE THAT drifted out a bit early then had speed inside, dropped back fast on the backstretch and turn, gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
