SEA OF SECRETS broke alertly and was close up early, quickly moved three deep and took a short lead, inched away on the turn and drew off under urging, then was in hand late. ARTAX broke a bit awkwardly and dueled three deep, was between rivals leaving the backstretch, dueled inside the winner, then was no match in the stretch and drifted in some. EMAILIT forced the early pace inside, came off the rail into the turn and bested the rest. STALWART TSU dueled between rivals early, dropped back and gave way. DRIGGS RETREAT unhurried off the rail early, angled in for the turn and was not a threat.
