SHAKE OFF stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, took a short lead past the eighth pole, inched away under urging and held on gamely. YINGYINGYING four wide into the first turn, chased between horses, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and finished well. MISS CORONADO angled in and chased a bit off the rail, awaited room off heels leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and again in midstretch and found her best stride late. BRAVE VIXEN drifted out into the first turn, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, battled outside the winner in the stretch but weakened late. WORKSFORMONEY floated out into the first turn, stalked off the rail then bid outside the leader and pressed the pace, was three deep nearing midstretch, had the rider lose the whip just past the eighth pole and also weakened. DROUGHT BREAKER five wide into the first turn, chased outside then three deep, angled in outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. SILVER HAWK LADY six wide into the first turn, stalked outside on the backstretch, angled in some on the second turn and weakened. MATZO BALL floated out into the first turn, stalked between horses on the backstretch, dropped back and angled in on the second turn and gave way.
