KARLEE'S KITTEN saved ground stalking the pace, slipped through along the rail on the second turn to take a short advantage nearing the stretch, fought back gamely through a long drive and narrowly prevailed under urging. AWESOME BROAD sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, battled outside the winner on the second turn and through the drive and went on willingly to the wire. WILDOUT broke outward and a bit slowly, angled in on the first turn then chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. QUIET KIM three deep on the first turn, stalked outside, bid three wide on the second turn, drifted in some in the stretch and weakened. GOLD ON GOSSAMER in a bit tight between foes into the first turn, chased outside a rival then off the rail, dropped back into the second turn, angled in for the stretch and had little left. ROSES R FOR GIRLS prompted the pace outside the runner-up, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased late.
