Footnotes

BOO TOO dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, came off the rail into the stretch, drifted out under left handed pressured then right handed urging and just held. TURBULENCE broke a bit slowly then was bumped and steadied, settled inside, moved up on the turn and into the stretch and rallied along the rail to just miss. OL'DOGTOWN had speed outside foes then dueled alongside the winner, stalked leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and narrowly edged a rival for third. FIVE A DAY close up stalking the pace inside, came out a bit in upper stretch, drifted in late and was edged for the show.

GLENWICK stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the stretch and weakened. GOOD GUY stalked outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. KID POKER bumped and steadied after the start, chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DAILY SUDS settled outside then off the fence, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. DEL MAR EXPRESS wide early, chased outside then alongside a rival into and on the turn and did not rally. WHOSONTOP broke slowly, settled off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and was not a threat. ETHIOPIAN chased outside then three deep, continued alongside a rival leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and weakened. EL CHUECO hesitated to be away behind the field, settled off the rail and was always outrun.
