Footnotes

THIRTYFIRSTSTREET stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the runner-up while drifting in under some left handed urging, gained the lead in deep stretch and proved best. MINT HUMOR sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the turn, inched away again in the stretch, fought back inside the winner in deep stretch, could not match that one late but held second. HUSBAND'S FOLLY squeezed a bit at the start, angled in and stalked inside, came out for room past midstretch, steadied off the heels of the winner a sixteenth out and was edged for the place. KALYRA CAT four wide early, stalked three deep to the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. TITIAN stalked a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the turn, was a bit crowded between foes in midstretch and weakened. ALL DE VICTORS between foes early, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. NAHEM chased between horses and steadied in a bit tight just past midway on the backstretch, angled in for the turn and weakened in the stretch. CONFLICTED TRAITS settled between horses chasing the pace on the backstretch and turn and lacked a response in the drive.
