DR. SMARTY JACK chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and proved best under steady handling. TIMES GONE BY attended the pace off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn, took the advantage leaving that turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back off the rail in the final furlong but could not match the winner late. HOG'S HOLLOW chased inside, went outside a rival leaving the backstretch, split horses into the second turn, continued inside on that bend, went between rivals in midstretch and held third. MEGASTAR a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail, went three deep into the second turn, continued alongside a rival on that bend, came out in the stretch and was edged for the show. ROOSTER CITY sped to the early lead and angled in, tugged on a clear advantage while setting the pace inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. TIZ ARGENT saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
