SATIN DOLLY sped to the early lead, dueled a bit off the rail then briefly between foes on the backstretch, turned back the bid of the runner-up in the stretch and won clear under urging. QUI'S RUSH IN forced the pace outside the winner then three deep on the backstretch, bid alongside on the second turn and in the stretch but could not match strides in the final furlong. FANCY BEGINING unhurried along the inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. TOOMANYTOMORROWS saved ground close up early, bid inside on the backstretch, fell back on the second turn and weakened. LADYLORE broke alertly then swerved inward when green, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. BELLA MASERA chased outside then off the rail, was alongside a rival on the second turn and weakened. BRITE F X settled a bit off the inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the second turn and was not a factor.
