RIDE AND SHINE saved ground off the pace, inched forward inside on the turn, swung out leaving the bend and three deep into the stretch, then rallied under left handed urging to get up late. SIMONY sped to the early lead, inched away on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. EX FEDERALI bumped with the runner-up at the start, chased inside, came out leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and bested the rest. EARL OF DANBY pressed the pace between horses on the backstretch, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. POPULAR forced the pace three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside a rival on the turn and also weakened. HYDER allowed to settle off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and dropped back.
