ADALGISA stalked the pace between horses then off the rail, continued outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short advantage nearing midstretch and held on gamely under urging. NANOGRAM chased a bit off the rail then between horses, continued outside a rival leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch, had the rider lose the right rein for the final furlong but closed gamely. SWEEP THE DECK sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged, fought back through a long, hard drive and continued willingly to the wire. STETSON LADY stalked the pace a bit off the rail, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn, continued between horses through the stretch and also went on willingly but was outfinished. MONROW saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and rallied late outside. SENORA POPPY stalked the pace along the inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LOOKN MIGHTY FINE allowed to settle off the rail or outside a rival, also came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. INNOCENT KISS (BRZ) was in a good position chasing three deep but weakened in the stretch.
