LUCKS MINE sped to the early lead from between horses, opened up on his field down the backstretch and around the turn and held on in the drive for the score. SUMMERS AT DELMAR stalked from the inside down the backstretch, angled out entering the lane and rallied to be second best. FACE AND AN ACE was outrun down the backstretch, was between horses on the turn, rallied late on the outside to be up for the show spot. HANDSOME JOHN stalked the pace outside a rival on the backstretch and around the turn, weakened in the final furlong and was nodded for third at the wire. CHURCHONSUNDAY stalked the early leader on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn and weakened in the final furlong. VEECU chased the leaders on the outside down the backstretch, remained outside on the turn and had no rally in the stretch drive. MAYBE YES was without any early speed and failed to gain any ground when asked in the lane. SGT. HITCHENS was off slowly, saved ground on the turn, but lacked a rally in the stretch drive. TASTE OF WINE was outrun throughout and without a rally in the lane.
