CAMP VICTORY pulled his way up to duel inside, inched away under left handed urging in the stretch and won clear. MISTER DO IT saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail in deep stretch and gained the place. NOSTALGIC BID chased a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch, was three deep in midstretch and was edged for second. KID EDWARD (IRE) a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival chasing the pace, waited off heels in midstretch, split rivals in deep stretch, angled in late and just missed a minor award. OCEANOGRAPHER sped to the early lead, angled in off the rail then dueled outside the winner to the stretch and weakened. MR TOKYO chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HENNESSY GOD broke slowly, settled off the rail then angled in for the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. DO WHAT U DARE chased between horses then outside, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SMOKIN BOMB stalked outside the winner then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
