TIME FOR ATONEMENT stalked three deep then outside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and got up late under some urging and strong handling. OBSESS had speed outside rivals then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside and held on gamely but was narrowly edged on the line. VULCAN chased off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and got up late outside foes for the show. SCORSESE a bit slow into stride, chased inside, split horses on the turn, angled back to the rail into the stretch, continued along the fence in the drive and was edged late for third. THREE POINTER stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn, was between rivals again in deep stretch and was outfinished late for the show. SLEW CITY GOLD close up stalking the pace inside, dropped back along the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
