Footnotes

STREETS OF HEAVEN stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up while being floated out some in midstretch, inched away under urging in deep stretch and proved best. SUPER HARMONY sent along to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, came off the rail into the stretch, fought back while drifting out in midstretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. GOLD TRIM pulled a bit then chased just off the rail, angled in on the backstretch, continued along the fence on the second turn and in the stretch and picked up the show. OH HOW NICE unhurried three deep early, angled in on the first turn, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. P FORTY WARHAWK angled in and stalked off the rail then outside the winner on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. MIND THE MINISTER four wide early, stalked three deep, continued outside on the second turn under urging, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened. KAYAKITYAK stalked the pace between horses, dropped back on the second turn, angled inward in the stretch, gave way and was eased late.
