EARNEDNEVERGIVEN sped to the early lead, set all the pace a bit off the rail and held on gamely under some urging. THE BAT SIGNAL brushed the side of the gate and was bumped at the start, chased outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and got up for the place outside foes. BELIEVE IN HOPE chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, split horses in deep stretch and went between foes for the show. MR. BOSSY PANTS stalked outside a rival then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. HUNCH a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and into the stretch, waited briefly behind the winner in midstretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. EL MARTILLO broke in the air and slowly, settled a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. SEA RASCAL had speed outside the winner then stalked off the rail, continued between horses on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
